The Admissions Committee will review your application only when it is complete, including the application form, letter of recommendation, TOEFL or IELTS report, evaluated law school transcripts and personal statement. If you answered "yes" to any question(s) in the character and fitness section on page 2 of the application, you must include written explanation(s). Once your file is complete you should receive a decision in approximately 3-4 weeks.

A personal statement not exceeding two pages is required and may be submitted with your application. At least one letter of recommendation is required of all applicants. A current resume is strongly recommended and should not exceed two pages. Please see the instructions for additional information.

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
