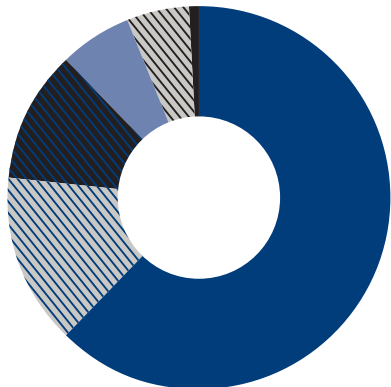

CLASS OF 2023 EMPLOYMENT

Numerous firms and public and private employers regularly recruit on campus. For the class of 2023, 86.9% of DePaul law graduates seeking employment reported being employed 10 months after graduation.*
