The Alumni Engagement Board (the “Board”) serves all College of Law alumni regardless of year of graduation, professional background or location.

How we’re organized

- The Board is a dedicated group of active, enthusiastic and committed College of Law Alumni. You may take on many leadership opportunities, including planning events, chairing committees or becoming an officer.
- The Alumni Engagement Board is comprised of 15 to 30 Directors. These Directors constitute the governing body of the Board, which means that the Directors determine and implement policy and decide what the Board does, giving you even more opportunities to develop/ deepen your relationship with various College of Law alumni, staff, faculty and other boards/committees associated with the College of Law.
- Being a Director entails a significant commitment. You are committing to active involvement with matters that come before the Board, which means that you are expected to attend all regular and special Board meetings, serve on at least one of the Board’s committees, participate in programs or events produced or sponsored by the Board and respond to Board request or communications in a timely manner.
- An appointed Director serves a two-year term, which you may renew one time, so you can serve as a Director for up to four years. If you are not able to presently commit to active involvement on the Board, then perhaps consider either applying for a Director position at a future date or start by volunteering to join one of the Board’s committees to get a feel for the external activities that the Board organizes. We do ask you to think carefully if you have the time and inclination to attend regular and special Board meetings and participate in committee and Board events.
