Class of 2023 - DePaul University College of Law Table 1 - Graduate Demographics









Class of 2023 - DePaul University College of Law Table 2 - Employment Status by Gender






Class of 2023 - DePaul University College of Law Table 4 - Employer Types by Gender





Class of 2023 - DePaul University College of Law Table 8 - Employment Status by Race/Ethnicity


