

Class of 2024 - DePaul University College of Law Table 2 - Employment Status by Gender





Class of 2024 - DePaul University College of Law Table 6 - Private Practice Detail by Gender







Class of 2024 - DePaul University College of Law Table 8 - Employment Status by Race/Ethnicity



Class of 2024 - DePaul University College of Law Table 9 - Employer Types by Race/Ethnicity




Class of 2024 - DePaul University College of Law Table 10 - Private Practice Detail by Race/Ethnicity
