WHAT IS INDEPENDENT STUDY (LAW 428)?

A student who has completed at least 40 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or above may apply to work under the supervision of a faculty member on an independent research project, resulting in a high-quality paper at least 35 pages in length. Independent Study satisfies the Advanced Writing Requirement.

Independent Study is a graded course that is offered for 3 credits. Students must complete at least 127.5 hours of research and writing over the course of the term to be granted credit. Students must submit detailed timesheets to the supervising faculty member every two weeks. Credit may be withheld for any student who fails to comply.

Please attach an outline of the paper proposal, signed by the supervising professor, to this form.
